 - Prize money will be awarded after Saturday's auction in the Office (S.E. corner of lunch stand). Approximately 3 PM.
 - Prize money not picked up by 4 PM on Sunday will be considered a donation and will not be forwarded by mail.
 - Ladies Fair Building will close at 2:30 PM on Sunday. **All entries** must be picked up between 4 and 5 PM on Sunday.
- The Fair Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any entry exhibited, but every precaution will be taken for the safe keeping of all entries.
